1.	Welcome and introductions – there were no Declarations of Interest	
2.	 Actions from May 2019 meeting ToR had been completed and circulated – they are now on SEMLEP website LBC have not progressed with the proposal to change the geography of the EZ area KM and LC did discuss the Energy Centre 	
3.	High Level Implementation Plan – LC led DART – opening June 2021 – on track - Bartlett Square – hotel development underway but everything else awaits the DART progress	

- Century Park Access Road Due to go to Full Council in November. Looking to develop some elements earlier including possible realignment of Percival Way. There is a possible automotive developer that could move to EZ site. This would reduce LBC risks on business rates. CPAR Phase 1 now includes dualling of Vauxhall Way to reduce congestion.
 - o Aim of Phase 1 CPAR is to deliver Century Park and central area of EZ
 - o Phase 2 is not progressing yet but is part of a bid from EEH for Major Roads Network funds.
 - o Some of the site may or may not be used for part of the airport growth as part of the DCO but that will not be determined until 2021
- BRU discussion about how the BRU may generate income and that the developer moving is already in Luton so no net gain on business rate income.
- LC stated that CPAR is not needed for the construction of automotive site but would be needed for its operation.
- Discussion about finance of CPAR:
 - o CPAR Phase 1 and Vauxhall Way including interest costs is £175M so larger than forecast BRU sum in D Lock report
 - o Noted that EZ and SEMLEP Board had agreed in principle to use BRU for EZ development subject to detailed proposals and finances being presented.
 - o LC confirmed that LBC are continuing to look for alternative funding
 - o Request for £175M is going to the Full Council in November but this means that LBC have to make £4m of additional savings each year in order to cover cost of borrowing.
 - o ST stated that members see the long term benefits of the scheme to create Luton jobs for Luton people
 - o LC confirmed options were being explored.
 - o There was a discussion about using different appraisal approaches and that MT had made clear the assurance framework had to be applied to BRU decisions. Before the SEMLEP Board could approve the use of BRU for this scheme then a full appraisal proportionate for a scheme of this size needed to be completed and reported to the EZ and SEMLEP Board.
- KM suggested trying to explore creative ways to focus on the vision and bring forward a scheme that could be funded.
- HC and JB confirmed that the CPAR business case needed a clear ask of the BRU to be considered and appraised. JB confirmed that SEMLEP have appointed Hatch Regeneris to appraise the scheme. **JB** and **LC** to speak to arrange the beginning to the appraisal process.
- AS was willing to help but nothing additional to offer at this stage
